Part 1 – Rising Awareness

Identify an important environment concern. Examples may include:

- Amount of garbage being produced and disposed of.
- Our dependence on fossil fuels to produce energy, power our cars, produce plastics and other materials, etc.
- Air Pollution – For example the increase on greenhouse gases in our atmosphere leading to global warming.
- Water Pollution - The pollution of our oceans, rivers, and lakes.
